1. Program Objectives

By the end of the program, participants will be able to:

- Develop foundational Arabic communication skills for daily and travel situations
- Gain cultural literacy through direct exposure to Jordanian society and Islamic heritage sites
- Strengthen the participant's proficiency in preparation for university-level entry Arabic test or higher education in the Arab world for those who are preparing themselves
- Strengthen global awareness and cross-cultural communication
- Build teamwork, adaptability, and leadership skills through experiential learning

Cultural & Historical Exploration and	Guided visits to significant historical, cultural, and religious sites in Jordan	Field leaning, reflective, travel-specific vocabulary	3–5 hours/day
Mentorship & Reflection	Guided discussion sessions to reflect on daily experiences and language use	Dialogue, journaling	Throughout
Social Immersion & Interaction	Engagement with local communities through workshop, markets, and public spaces	Real-life practice	Daily
